- CWOCNs publish a quarterly newsletter dedicated to skin and wound care disseminated to all nurses and skin champions.
- CWOCNs work with the Patient Advisory council to provide effective education to patients.

TJHU encourages the CWOCN team to share knowledge, support colleagues from other disciplines, and most importantly, improve patient care and outcomes.
