- Conduct unit rounding for pressure injury prevention, providing education to unit nurses and leadership
- Adding a WTA Course Coordinator, extending the CWOCN team with 8 Wound Treatment Associate-Certified (WTA-C®) and more expected to become certified
- CWOCN team educates all new nurses and nurse extenders through lectures during orientation
- CWOCN team provides education to new Residents, Plastic Surgery Physician Assistants, wound care center Nurse Practitioner orientation
- Provides prevention of acute pressure injuries in acute spinal cord injured patients and tracheostomy patients

Christiana Care Health System encourages the CWOCN team to share knowledge, support colleagues from other disciplines, and most importantly, improve patient care and outcomes.
